The columns in the table below are displayed in the same order as the National Insurance table in SIMS Personnel.

Please Note:-

1. SIMS Personnel and FMS6 have been designed to use and apply the National Insurance percentage that is applicable on the first day of the calendar month when calculating salary projections in FMS6. Please consider when entering the revised National Insurance table for 2022/2023:-

- a. If the revised National Insurance table is entered with an effective date of 06/11/2022, the FMS6 salary projections will use the percentage applicable as at 1^{st} November 2022, 15.05% for the whole month, resulting in a higher projection that the anticipated National Insurance projection for November 2022.
- b. If the revised National Insurance table is entered with an effective date of 01/11/2022, the FMS6 salary projections will use the percentage applicable as at 1st November 2022, 13.80% for the whole month, resulting in a lower projection that the anticipated National Insurance for November 2022.
- 2. The salary projection for following months/accounting periods will use the new revised percentages from November 2022.
